Rising 3<sup>rd</sup> graders: Reflex two green lights per week, ixl Summer Boost Skill Plan once per week

Rising 4<sup>th</sup> graders: ixl – Summer Boost Skill Plan twice per week Rising 5<sup>th</sup> graders: ixl – Summer Boost Skill Plan twice per week
