GPA Providence uses the following designations to indicate course work level: Honors (H), Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE). Any class not having one of the previous designations is considered a college preparatory course. A cumulative weighted and unweighted GPA are provided on the transcript. All courses taken are used in GPA calculations. Honors (H) courses receive an additional .5 weight, Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE) courses receive an additional 1.0 weight.
